

Cadbury Caramilk in Australia
190g chocolate block
Best before dates of 17/01/2019 and 21/01/2019 only

Thursday 15 February 2018: Mondelēz International has initiated a trade and consumer food recall of its 190g Cadbury Caramilk chocolate block **sold in Australia only** with **best before dates of 17/01/2019 and 21/01/2019**.

A limited number of the Cadbury Caramilk products have been found to contain small, flexible pieces of food grade plastic as a result of a machinery fault during the manufacturing process.

Products containing plastic may cause minor injury if consumed. Our analysis of the samples received to date has determined that this product does not appear to pose a serious health or food safety risk, but the quality and safety of our products, as well as our consumers, is our first priority and a recall has been initiated to prevent the risk of minor injury.

Affected product should not be consumed and should be returned to the place of purchase for a full refund - no proof-of-purchase is required.

Our investigations confirm that this is an isolated incident, limited to Cadbury Caramilk product sold in Australia only with the **best before dates of 17/01/2019 and 21/01/2019 only**.

No other Mondelēz International or Cadbury brand or product is affected. Cadbury Caramilk products sold in New Zealand and all other Caramilk products sold in Australia with different best before dates, are not affected by this recall.
